**Amoskeag Fishways Visitors Center**, 100 Elm St, 603-626-3474, M-Sa 9am-5pm, [amoskeagfishways.org](http://amoskeagfishways.org) – year-round environmental educational programs and exhibits, focusing on the natural and cultural history of the Merrimack River and its watershed.

**Currier Museum of Art and Frank Lloyd Wright's Zimmerman House**, 150 Ash Street, 603-669-6144, [currier.org](http://currier.org), Sun, Mon, Wed-Fri 11am-5pm, Sat 10am-5pm (admission free 10am-2pm), first Thurs of each month 11 am-8pm; adult \$10, Senior \$9, Student \$8, Children under 18 free; with Zimmerman House tour adult \$18, Senior \$17, Student \$16, Children 7-17 \$8. Shuttle bus from museum to Zimmerman House for tours.

**Millyard Museum**, Mill No. 3, 200 Bedford Street (entrance at the corner of Commercial and Pleasant Streets), 603-622-7531, [manchesterhistoric.org](http://manchesterhistoric.org), Wed-Sat 10-4. Museum features the permanent exhibit Woven in Time: 11,000 Years at Amoskeag Falls. Adults \$6, Seniors & College Students \$5, Children 6-18 free.

**Millyard Research Center and Library**, 129 Amherst St, 603-622-7531, [manchesterhistoric.org](http://manchesterhistoric.org), Wednesdays and Saturdays 10am-4pm; ticket to Millyard Museum will also include entrance into Research library on the same day, or vice versa.
